  2. What aspects of the Flagler Museum Summer Camp interest you the most and how will you use the experience of attending Camp to positively influence your studies?
3. Parent Essay\* (500 words or less, double spaced, 1 inch margins, 12 pt. font)  
Please provide a written statement about your child's academic interests, involvement in extra-curricular activities, and any additional information about your child that may help the Scholarship Committee best understand your family's need for financial assistance.
